## Medicaid Service Coordination

**Medicaid Service Coordinators** take a person-centered approach with the individuals and families they serve. They act as liaisons between other service agencies to secure services/programming. They work with the individuals and their circle of support (family members, colleagues, friends) to achieve their goals and dreams. Service Coordinators begin by applying for eligibility through OPWDD as well as Medicaid. Once that process is complete, they assist in securing programming through the Home & Community Based Waiver, through OPWDD.
